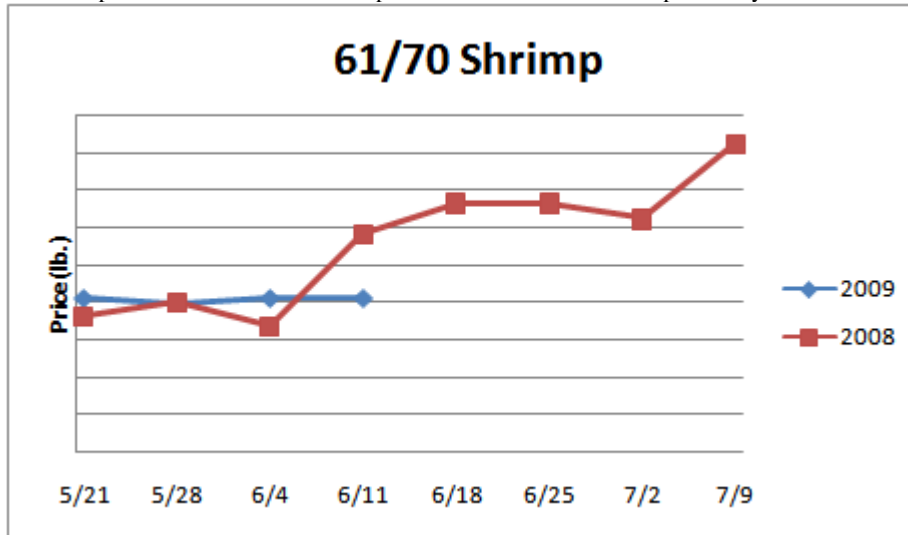


Seafood Report

Seafood- Total April US shrimp imports were 6.3% greater than last year. Shell on shrimp imports during April were also more (1.3%) than the prior year. A devalued US dollar could temper US shrimp imports in the coming months. Still, lackluster demand may cause many shrimp markets to trend below year ago levels for the foreseeable future. April US salmon filet/steak imports were 5.6% less than the previous year.
