The Alaskan snow crab fishing season is winding down with 83% of the quota landed as of early March. The Alaskan quota this season is down 12.1% from the previous year and the smallest in over a decade. World snow crab supplies are limited and are likely to remain so for the next several months. This should continue to underpin the snow crab markets.
